### **Featuring Keynote Speaker - Dr. Armando Arias**

Dr. Armando Arias, is a Professor of Interdisciplinary Studies, and Professor of Social & Behavioral Sciences at California State University. He served as the Dean of the College of Arts & Sciences at Texas A&M University and helped build several brand new campuses for the system. In recent years, Dr. Arias provided project leadership for the creation of the Big Sur Environment Institute in Big Sur, California. The Institute brings together world-class thinkers and scientists to develop global environmental solutions, while at the same time offering service learning opportunities for students. The institute is often referred to as the “Camp David for the Environment.” As an undergraduate student, Dr. Arias helped with the build-out of numerous new entities at UCSD like the student union, Che Café, scuba and sailing clubs and program board. As a graduate student he participated in accreditation review committees for the Departments of Sociology, Psychology, Philosophy and Community Studies; last year at the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the graduate division he was recognized as a member of the first graduating class to earn Ph.D.’s at UCSD and also as a Distinguished Alum.
